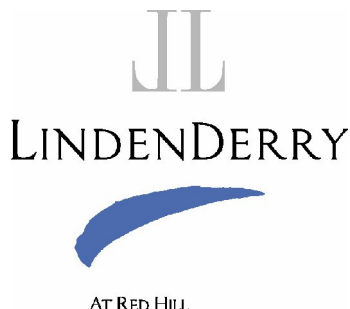

SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

1. The theme for the 2010 competition will be
“**The Mornington Peninsula – Then and Now**” which will be
broadly interpreted as anything to do with the Mornington
Peninsula past and present, such as landscapes, seascapes,
animals, flowers, people etc.
2. Exhibits must not exceed 1200cm x 900cm and paintings
may be framed but **MUST** be wired and ready for exhibition.
3. Each exhibit must be the original work of the artist.
4. Works may be for sale or for exhibition only. Works for
exhibition only should be designated NFS on the Entry Form.

Works for sale – contact details of the person wishing
to purchase the work will be passed on to the artist.

5. Works must not have been exhibited at a previous
Show.
6. The following information must be clearly marked
on the back of each exhibit – artist’s name, address,
title of work, price (if applicable) and medium. A
SMALL CARD, (BUSINESS CARD SIZE) WITH THE
ARTIST’S NAME, TITLE OF WORK, MEDIUM, PRICE
OR NFS, IN CLEAR LETTERING MUST ALSO
ACCOMPANY EACH EXHIBIT.
7. Any damage to, or loss of any exhibit howsoever
or whenever occurring, and whether whilst in transit or
display or otherwise, shall be the sole responsibility of
the exhibitor. Exhibits will be handled by experienced
Stewards, and with care.
8. All exhibits must be handed to the Stewards at the
Art/Craft Pavilion on the Showgrounds **between the
hours of 1pm and 3pm on Thursday 25 March
2010.**
9. Prizes and Society Sashes will be presented to
each winning exhibitor on Show Day. Presentation
Time will be 4.00pm and all artists are asked to attend
personally to receive their awards.
10. **Exhibits can be collected after 4.30pm on
Show Day.**
11. Exhibitors are responsible for the removal of their
exhibits by 4.45pm on Saturday, 27 March 2009
12. A maximum number of 4 entries will be accepted
from each artist.

SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

1. The Head Steward has the right to combine classes if there are insufficient entries, and to transfer any exhibit to its correct class if incorrectly entered.
2. The Judges have the right to withhold awards when the exhibits are not of a minimum standard.
3. Name and address of the exhibitor, title of the photograph and class number must be clearly marked in block letters on the back of each exhibit. IF THE TITLE OF THE PICTURE IS TO BE DISPLAYED IT MUST ALSO BE ATTACHED IN SOME WAY TO THE FRONT OF THE MOUNT
4. Maximum size of exhibits 51cm x 41cm (20in x 16 in) and they must be mounted on mountboard or cardboard.
5. **No framed prints or prints under glass will be accepted.**
6. To avoid damage to mounts when staging the exhibition, the Show Society Stewards will display photographs by attaching "Velcro" dots to the back of the mount.
7. Exhibits must remain on display until 4.30pm on Show Day and must be claimed between 4.45pm and 5.00pm on Show Day on presentation of the duplicate entry form
8. Entries will be returned by post if return postage is included and entry form is marked accordingly.
9. The Society will take all care, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
10. Limit of 5 entries per class.
11. No prices are to be listed on the front of photographs.
12. The Judges decision is final.

2nd Prize Society Ribbon, 3rd Prize Society Ribbon
