Small, miniature and pompone dahlias to be staged 3 blooms to a container unless otherwise stated. Tiered shelving provided.

#### **DAHLIA CLASSES:**

1. Medium Decorative, 1 bloom, any colour (160- 210mm)
2. Pompone, 3 blooms, distinct varieties
3. Any Variety, 1 bloom
4. Small Cactus, 3 blooms, NND (80-160mm)
5. Container of Dahlias, viewed from the front

#### **CUT FLOWERS, TREES AND SHRUBS:**

6. 1 Container of Roses NND
7. 1 Rose
8. 1 Container of Old Fashioned Style Roses NND,CVA
9. Hydrangea, 1 head, any colour
10. Hydrangeas, 3 heads, 3 colours
11. Fuchsia, 1 container, cut stems
12. Petunias, 1 Container, CVA
