Purchased with entries or at the gate. Allows entry for 1 car & float/truck & occupants.

REGULATIONS - HORSES

To be read in conjunction with General Regulations and specific regulations for rings.

1. Novice: Never to have won first prize at an Agricultural Show.
2. All competitors compete at their own risk.
3. Height Certificates: Where height is a condition in a class, the exhibitor **MUST** be in possession of a measurer's certificate. Current height certificates issued by the RASV, EV, VAS Ltd and the MHAA are recognised by this society and must be produced on demand.
4. An approved safety helmet is required for all riders at all times when mounted. The retaining harness must be secured and fastened at all times. Riders without approved headgear shall be ineligible to compete until rectified. Approved helmet standards are: AS/NZS 3838, EN 1384, ASTN F1163.

5. Every exhibitor or competitor shall be bound by, and observe, the decisions and directions of the Society.

6. Protests : An exhibitor or competitor may protest against an award won by another exhibitor or competitor in the same class alleging infringement of the rules or ineligibility. Such protests shall be addressed to the Secretary no longer than one hour after the award has been presented. The protest must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00 which will be forfeited to the Society if the protest is found to be unfounded or frivolous. Protests and all matters arising therefrom shall be determined by three members of the Horse Section Committee, the Secretary and the President of the Show Society.

7. The Society reserves the right to reject at any time any entry or prohibit any person or any animal from competing in any class. The Society also reserves the right to cap entries

8. The judge may award a second or third prize instead of a first, and may withhold one altogether where there is only one exhibitor or where the exhibits are not considered of a satisfactory standard.

9. The Society reserves the right to alter or delete the program as necessary.

10. Driving or riding of horses about the grounds or arenas (except in the designated warm-up areas), is not allowed until called for judging & persons in charge of horses are requested to be in readiness in order that Judges & Stewards are not delayed in their work.

11. All stallions/colts must be bitted.

12. Stallions/Colts must be handled/ridden by an exhibitor 18yrs and over. Stallions/Colts are not permitted to enter in any other sections, than those provided for ENTIRES (Stallions/Colts), unless stated otherwise in schedule.

13. To comply with Occupational Health & Safety regulations, horses will be restricted to their allocated area, and walkways will be provided to assist with access to rings. NO horse is to be led, ridden or tethered amongst spectators.

14. No refunds of entry or admittance fees under any circumstances.

15. Horse age dates from 1st August.

16. Prizes awarded at the Show, left unclaimed by 5pm on the day will be forfeited.

17. Local competitor must live within the Mornington Peninsula Shire.

18. Veterinary Services. Exhibitors of large animals are advised that a Veterinary Surgeon will be available on an "ON CALL" basis. Should an animal require Veterinary treatment, then the cost of such treatment must be met by the owner of the animal.

19. Only horses/ponies entered to compete in the Show, are to be present on the showgrounds.
20. In the interests of public safety competitors MUST comply immediately with any request that they may receive from a show society representative. Failure to do so may result in disqualification or removal from the showgrounds.
21. Gates open to competitors at 7.30 am.
22. NO CAMPING, on the showgrounds permitted under any circumstances, either prior to or after the event.
23. Entries are NOT transferable.
24. Only dogs competing in showday competitions are allowed on the grounds.
26. Performances gained at this show MAY NOT qualify the exhibit / exhibitor for the VAS Ltd Horse of the Year Show OR Royal Melbourne Show (RAS).
27. KEEP EQUINE INFLUENZA OUT OF VICTORIA. With this in mind bio-security measures will be observed during the running of ALL Horse & Pony events conducted by the Red Hill A & H Society Inc.
28. Competitors are requested to please clear up hay and manure and place in marked bins before leaving the ground.

2. Any person under suspension or expulsion from any miniature equine society is unable to show at MPMPG shows and their entries will not be accepted.
3. The committee will measure horses on the day. Audiovisual monitoring of measuring will be undertaken.
4. No refunds will be given.
5. Registration papers must be available on the day if requested.
6. The Judge's decision is final.
7. All stallions must be bitted to avoid injury.
8. **No person under the age of 18 years is permitted to handle/lead a colt/stallion at this show.**
9. All foals must be haltered in the ring.
10. The Committee reserves the right to combine or split classes.
11. Exhibitors are required to make themselves aware of risk management requirements and comply with them.
12. Random swabbing may be undertaken at the Committee's discretion. Any animals testing positive will be disqualified.
13. All exhibitors must comply with the code of conduct which will be displayed on the day.
