SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations)

1. General Regulations are printed in the Entry Folder and are also available on the society website at www.redhillshow.org.
2. Exhibitors must use the official Entry Form (also available from the society website) to enter birds into the Show.
3. All entry fees must be included at the time entry forms are submitted.
4. **Entry forms must be submitted two weeks prior to the day of the show.**
5. If you are a show society member make this clear on your entry form.
6. If the number of entries exceeds the number of available display cages, some entries may have to be rejected.
7. **Birds to be benched by 9.00am on the day of Show and must not be removed before 4.30pm. Please leave a contact number with the Head Steward.**
8. Exhibits to be brought to and from the Showgrounds by the exhibitor or their representative on the day of the Show. The Society will not collect or deliver birds.
9. Under no circumstances are exhibitors or the public to communicate with or otherwise interfere with the Judge during judging.
10. Birds will not be removed without permission of the Poultry Steward.
11. Poultry that are for sale need to have details left with the Head Steward on price, etc.
12. **Food & Containers – need to be provided by the exhibitor and taken with you on collection of your exhibit/s.**
13. Abbreviations: AOC = Any Other Colour.
AOV = Any Other Variety

PRIZES: Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the judge. Prizes will only be awarded if the judge decides that the poultry meets show standards. Not every class will automatically get a prize.
