SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations).

- All stud sheep entered must be from registered studs in accordance with the rules of their particular Society and NLIS requirements. Sheep not in accordance with such rules will be disqualified from Stud Sheep Classes (1-56)
- Sheep (except lambs) must be shorn after July 1st 2011
- Border Leicester exhibitors must not use powders or other substances on the face and/or colour on legs and feet in the preparation of sheep for showing.
- **Please Note: Exhibits may be penned on Friday 23 March after 4.30pm by arrangement**
- Sheep exhibits will be released to owners from 4.30pm on Show Day.
- **Sheep Health Statement - Victoria** (attached) must be completed and signed at time of entry by the exhibitor or agent of the exhibitor.

A COPY OF THE CURRENT OVINE BRUCELLOSIS CERTIFICATE OR BRUCELLOSIS TEST RESULTS MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ENTRY

SECTION REGULATIONS: (To be read in conjunction with General Regulations and Stud Sheep Regulations. Please note regulations referring to the Sheep Health Statement form which must be completed and signed at time of entry).

- All sheep should have no more than 12 months, nor less than 5cm wool.
- Lambs are not eligible for Championships. NOTE: Lambs are still judged as lambs as long as all milk teeth are still in place.
- All sheep and fleece exhibitors must be current financial members of the BCSBAA Inc, SECSOS or similar society.
- All sheep and fleece exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
- **Red Hill Show Black & Coloured Sheep Junior Handler Award – The Sonia McKillop Memorial Perpetual Trophy.** All Black & Coloured Sheep Junior Handlers must be under 18 years of age at date of Show. This competition is to encourage younger and new handlers to gain an interest in the field of agriculture.
- Best Wether classes – any wool type. Judged on trueness to breed and wool type.
- Judge has the right to move a sheep to a different class if they feel the sheep is entered incorrectly.

Sheep infected with footrot or any external parasite OR animals from an infected or suspected flock are not eligible to be exhibited.
